

## General information and House Rules



- 👉 At Lali Jiwa, you'll have the entire property and all amenities to yourself.
- 👉 You will have a dedicated Villa Manager, Oka, who is your go-to person for anything you want during your stay. He will meet you on arrival.
- 👉 You will have complimentary house keepers who will tidy, clean and wash linen, plus a gardener. You can arrange with Oka how often and at what time they come, so you're not surprised by their arrival.
- 👉 Before each booking, the Villa is cleaned to a standard that is consistent with the guidelines to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. All staff wear masks and gloves and maintain social distancing.
- 👉 Each of the bedrooms can be locked. The master has a small, security safe.
- 👉 Lali Jiwa is ideal for families but probably not those with young children who can't swim or need constant supervision. The pool isn't fenced and at the bottom of the property, there is a drop off to the beach.
- 👉 Don't drink the tap water or use it to clean your teeth - it can give you "Bali Belly". So unlimited filtered, bottled water is included during your stay. Use this to make ice and fill your bottle when heading out.
- 👉 Smoking is not allowed in any of the rooms in the villa, the outdoor living spaces nor on any of the outdoor furniture please. We appreciate you adhering to this.
- 👉 The air conditioners are there to be used. During the day, try to remember to turn them off, plus any lights.
- 👉 The showers have good pressure and hot water. Take care to adjust the temperature beforehand.
- 👉 The entrance to the infinity pool is the shallow end. The deepest point is about 180cm.
- 👉 Good quality, complimentary Wi-Fi is included when you book.
- 👉 The property can be secured behind gates, and there also is a security check point near the entrance.
- 👉 There are no strong currents or rips in the ocean out the front, nor any nasties. But be careful entering and exiting the water as there is no sand but smooth, large and small, washed stones. High tide is the better time to snorkel. The beach isn't really suited to chilling on a towel. Remember to close the private gate as the neighbouring goats can enter the property and devour, in quick time, the tropical garden.
- 👉 If walking in to Tulamben, especially at night time, be careful because the footpaths can be uneven.
- 👉 Insects aren't normally a problem at the villa, but you might want to pack some repellent and definitely bring sun screen. Apart from your personal items, there's not much else you need to pack. Being tropical, and with open living, you may have small geckos as guest lodgers. They are harmless but are great at catching insects - they can also be quite vocal at times when they call to each other.
- 👉 You can hire any beach related gear, scooter etc through Oka. Info is provided on the next page.
- 👉 The villa has private, secure undercover parking if you have your own car or scooter, plus an additional parking space out the front for your visitors.
- 👉 Please report any issues, appliances not working, damages or breakages immediately to Oka.
- 👉 Check-in time is no earlier than 2pm. Check-out time is 11am. Other times can be requested. Oka will be there to say goodbye and ensure all is in order.
